



The Crew Absentee Tracking System (CATS) is a Flight Attendant's record of absences (dates, types, and dependability points).


CATS Self-Service Log-In Instructions

1. Access the CATS application.
2. On the Sign In screen, enter your Frontier Active Directory username and password. This is the same username and password used to access the crew room computers.
