

Get to Know Miami International Airport

The Miami International Airport (MIA) is South Florida's main airport for long-haul international flights and a hub for the southeastern United States. It is the largest gateway between the United States and south to Latin America, and is one of the largest airline hubs in the United States.

Miami International Airport is located at 2100 NW 42nd Ave, Miami, FL 33126

There are 3 terminals (North, Central, and South) and 6 concourses. Frontier Airlines ticket counters and baggage carousels are both located in Concourse F. Frontier flights also operate out of Concourse F.

KCM is located upstairs in the Concourse F, TSA Exit Lane, across from curbside door 14.

Interesting Things About MIA:

- **MIA Airport App** - The MIA App integrates state-of-the-art, location-based technology with more than 500 data beacons installed throughout MIA to provide a personalized travel experience. Users can scan their boarding pass for the latest flight info and updates, navigate the airport with blue-dot technology, and find the closest shopping and dining, including walk times, based on their customizable personal profile.
- **Pet Relief Areas** - Furry travelers have four private restrooms available at the airport. They are located post-security in concourse D near gate D34, concourse F near gate F7, concourse G near gate G5, and concourse J near gate J3.
- **Military Hospitality Lounge** - The Military Hospitality Lounge is a military-only lounge located in the center part of Miami International Airport to the right of the TSA entry point Concourse E across from the Air Margaritville restaurant. If you have just arrived from a flight, you will have to leave the secured area to access the Lounge.

- **Nursing Suite Pods**- MIA offers 9 nursing pods that are conveniently located post-security in every concourse. They are located near gates D20, D36, E9, E21, F6, G4, H4, J7, and J5.
 - **Metrorail Transportation System** - Metrorail is Miami's subway system. You can use this train system if you are traveling in/around the Miami area. For more information on the Metrorail visit <https://www.miamidade.gov/metrorail.page>
 - **Tri-Rail Transportation System** - Tri-Rail is South Florida's commuter system. You can use this train if you are traveling between Miami, Fort Lauderdale, and West Palm Beach. All Metrorail and Tri-Rail trains depart/arrive from MIA's Central Station. The free MIA Mover will connect you between MIA Central Station and the main airport terminal.
