

Get to Know Cleveland Hopkins International Airport

Cleveland Hopkins is the primary airport serving Greater Cleveland and Northeast Ohio. It the largest and busiest airport in the state, as well as the 43rd-busiest airport in the U.S. by passenger numbers. Located in Cleveland's Hopkins neighborhood 9 miles southwest of Downtown Cleveland, it is adjacent to the Glenn Research Center, one of NASA's ten major field centers.

Cleveland Hopkins International Airport is located at 5300 Riverside Dr, Cleveland, OH 44135.

The airport consists of one two-level passenger terminal with 4 concourses.

Frontier Airlines ticket counter and baggage carousels are on the C concourse where Frontier also operates its flights.

KCM is available at the Main Terminal: Central Exit Lane. The hours of operations for this KCM location are 0400 - 2000.
